About Wilderness Little Kulala

Stargaze in one of the darkest places on Earth, and sleep out under the stars, contemplating space, and your place in it.

Recently refurbished, Wilderness Little Kulala entices with its adventures, its landscapes, its peace. Home ground is the pristine, 27 000-hectare Kulala Wilderness Reserve in the Namib, aka The Living Desert. You can't get much closer to the renowned dunes of Sossusvlei and the evocative panoramas of Dead Vlei, accessible through an exclusive-use gate.

Climb Sossusvlei's 300-metre red dunes and gaze upon oceans of sand. Hike through Sesriem Canyon, carved by water over the millennia. Float above the world's oldest desert in a hot-air balloon. See the desert come alive on nature walks, drives, e-bikes, or low-impact quad bikes.

Under verdant trees on the Kunene's banks, in an ancient landscape, discover Wilderness Serra Cafema.


The camp's home is in the 300 000-hectare Marienfluss Conservancy, owned primarily by the Himba and a model of impact-focused tourism.

A place to disconnect, unwinding to the sound of rushing water, and the silence of the desert. Rest on the elevated deck of your suite, just one of eight whose wood, canvas, thatch, and exquisite interior design pay homage to Himba culture.

Respectfully engage with the transient Himba, and observe their fascinating lifestyle. Hear their stories, share yours. Water levels permitting, boat on the river, with Angola's Serra Cafema...

About Wilderness Hoanib Skeleton Coast Camp

Dine under impossibly starry skies, perhaps at the firepit as a jackal cries or lion roars.

Remote Wilderness Hoanib rests in Namibia's famed, ancient Kaokoveld – an otherworldly landscape of immense dunes and rocky mountains. The camp's eight pale olive, generously appointed, tented suites peak like whitecaps on an ocean of sand. Totally solar-powered, its open design and colour palette reflect the surrounding desert.

Take a rollicking drive to the Skeleton Coast, wild, windswept and seemingly stretching to infinity. Search the rust-coloured crags and arid plains for desert-adapted wildlife – elephants, lions, hyenas, giraffes. En-route explore desert oases and fly back to camp for an aerial view of what seems uninhabitable, but is life- giving.
